1. **Sort One:** One rider. Sort one numbered calf out of pen. # of calf will be called at start of 90 second time.
2. **Ranch Sorting:** Teams of two. \$40/2 rides, \$60/4 rides. One draw for each picked team.
3. **Working Ranch Horse:** 2 elements. First is pattern work, then boxing a single calf for 45 seconds. Score is based on combination of the two elements. Pattern 10 reining portion:
